The videos will be commented by Adel Taher, GP and diving&hyperbaric physician (Egypt) and Nico Schellart, PhD (NL).

Accreditation for NL sports-diving physicians will be applied for. For accreditation attendance and a test are mandatory. Registration fee € 135 and non-physicians € 60.
